JOB PURPOSE:

To ensure that designated areas of the school premises are kept in a clean and hygienic condition.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The main duties of school cleaner are to clean a set area, which will include a number of classrooms, corridors and pupil toilets to the required standard.
- Cleaning duties are:
- Cleaning, washing and sweeping.
- Emptying of litter bins.
- Polishing and dusting, where appropriate
- Using powered equipment (e.g. vacuum cleaners, polishers) where appropriate.
- To undertake such other duties as may be reasonably requested by the Principal, Cleaning Supervisor or Premises Manager
